

MARBLE USE AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

CONGRATULATIONS with your new Marble furniture. Marble is a natural limestone material created through decades of compression and heat. This beautiful material therefore comes out unique in its structure where no 2 products will look the same. This is why we love marble!

However, being a natural limestone material marble can scratch, break as well as absorb liquids. Three things you want to avoid to leave your product looking clean and fresh for a long time.

- Cleaning should be done with a damp, soft cloth. Do not use any abrasive materials or compounds when wiping the surface (no rough kitchen sponges). It will scratch.
- Always wipe away liquids spilled on the surface soonest possible afterwards. Limestone will absorb liquids, which may therefore leave permanent marks. Be especially careful with colored and acidic liquids, which should be wiped away immediately if spilled.
- Marble can crack if subjected to heavy blows.
